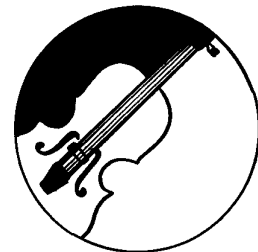
The Long Island Composers Alliance returns to the South Country Library to showcase their new, recent, or best work and discuss the process involved with writing their pieces.

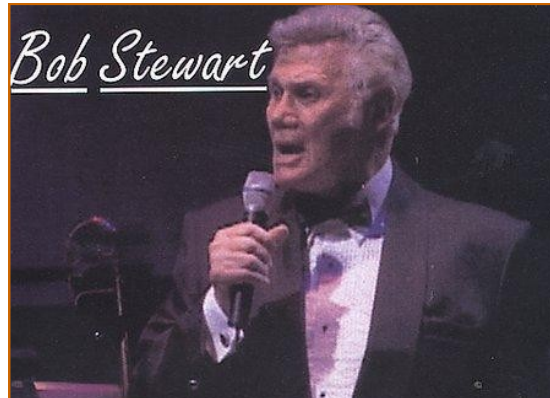
